CHECK IN

Location and directions will be sent to you prior to the start of your camp session. All maps and directions are posted on our camp website: www.DukeSoccerSchool.com. Check-in will be held from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. the first day of your camp week with a full afternoon schedule to follow, commuters included.

CHECK OUT

Check out for all campers will take place in the dormitories following the closing ceremonies at 10:00 a.m. Commuters will check out from the field.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

Shuttle service to and from the Raleigh-Durham airport, Durham Bus Station, and the Durham train station is available. The service includes pickup at the baggage claim upon arrival and drop off outside the terminal at departure. Interested campers need to check the appropriate box on the application or contact the camp office as soon as possible. Times of arrival and departure are needed to confirm the shuttle reservation. The \$50 fee is due immediately upon confirmation.

KEY/ACCESS CARD DEPOSIT

There will be a \$60 (cash) deposit due at registration. This will be given back at the end of camp upon return of key and card *only*. Please DO NOT send the key deposit in advance. For lost cards or keys, the deposit will be withheld—NO exceptions.

Camp Objective

The primary purpose of our camp is to help make you a better soccer player. Our camp is designed to improve the skill level and tactical understanding of all players. Training and game sessions will be intense and competitive to challenge every level of the player's ability. During the evening full-sided matches, we encourage you to exhibit the skills you have learned during the daily sessions. Our staff is highly qualified and motivated to help our camp and the individual participants reach our objectives. We are enthusiastic about making your camp experience rewarding and enjoyable. A written evaluation will be provided for each camper at the completion of camp.

Health Care & Insurance

A health history form and insurance form will be emailed once we have received the application, or may be printed from our website at DukeSoccerSchool.com. A camper is not allowed to compete unless we have a fully completed health form, signed by a physician, on file. Athletic trainers are on duty at all times to administer to minor injuries and sickness.

Team Discounts

Discount for groups of 10 or more enrolling together is \$30 per camper (resident) or \$20 per camper (commuter). All applications must be received in the same envelope. There is no team discount for online applicants. Teams will room, practice and play matches together if requested. A \$200 deposit per camper is required with each enrollment.

Commuters

Commuter fees include instruction, lunch, and dinner. Commuter campers must check in on the first day of camp at the same time and location as resident campers. On the following days commuter sessions run from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Facilities and Accommodations

Residential campers will be housed two per room in the Duke Dormitories. As your child's safety is our priority, campers are under constant supervision of counselors and dormitory personnel. Roommate preferences will be accommodated when possible, but is not guaranteed and a request must be made in advance. If no roommate is requested, assignments will be made according to age.

Air-conditioned rooms will be limited due to summer construction and will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. For a better chance of getting an air-conditioned room, send in application (both if requesting a roommate) and full payment as early as possible.

About The Camp Staff

The strength behind the Duke Soccer School for Girls is the knowledge, experience, and ability of the camp staff. The staff is led by the coaches at Duke, but campers are also exposed to coaches from many college and high school programs. You will get to know members of the Duke women's soccer team who will work as camp counselors.

Refund Policy

The Deposit of \$200 is subtracted from the total fee, **but is non-refundable for any reason and will be applied to the following years' camp tuition.** No refunds will be issued upon expulsion or voluntary withdrawal from camp once camp has begun.

Camp Ball and T-Shirt

All campers must have a soccer ball when they attend camp. You may bring your own or purchase the official Duke Soccer Ball.

At \$30, this is an outstanding offer. Payment for the ball must accompany your application. The ball can be picked up at registration. A Duke Soccer School for Girls T-shirt is included in the cost of tuition.

2010 ELITE POSITIONAL CAMP

The Elite Positional Camp is offered for serious and advanced soccer players. The camp will place emphasis on preparing top level 9-12 graders for play at the elite level. Training sessions are developed by the Duke women's soccer staff and include the use of current Duke soccer players, as well as highly skilled coaching staff members from other colleges and successful ODP and club programs.

Specific positional training will enhance and develop technical skills and tactical awareness for the highly competitive player. Campers will utilize the same elite athletic facilities our Duke student-athletes experience. Campers will be housed in the R. David Thomas Executive Conference Center on Duke's West Campus. Feature areas of emphasis will include speed and agility training, weight training, nutrition and academic preparation. Elite positional camp is open to individuals, club or high school teams.
